

5. The General Secretary, District Bar Association, Peshawar. Member



TERMS OF REFERENCE

The 'Terms of Reference' for the Committee tasked with 'Curbing Corruption by Paralegal Staff' are as under:

1. In the first instance, the Committee will conduct 'Integrity Profiling' of paralegals based on comments from respective courts, the Bar, track records, and discreet inquiries.
2. In the second phase, the Committee will perform a "spotting" of officials with questionable credentials who are suspected of being corrupt.
3. In the third phase, the Committee will advise the Authority on appropriate disciplinary actions against the delinquents.
4. The Committee will gather data on all types of corruption allegations and update the Integrity Profile of Paralegal Staff on regular basis as a continuous anti-corruption mechanism.
5. The Committee shall update the District and Sessions Judge about progress on its assignment on monthly basis.
6. The Committee will keep track of the actions taken in response to allegations of corruption against paralegal staff.
7. Monthly, the Committee shall issue a certificate stating that no complaints of corruption have been received against the Para-Legal Staff.
8. The Committee may settle on an appropriate schedule for performing its task. The Committee may decide an appropriate schedule for completing its task.
9. All the matters/complaints emerging against the staff at District Judiciary Peshawar shall be referred to the Anti-Corruption Committee at the first instance which will take the action according to the complaint.
